- Site Boundary
- Existing grass sward to be maintained with all naturalised planting to be removed by cutting trees off at the base (root removal by mechanical means is prohibited). Regular maintenance by cutting back of naturalised species is required.
- Proposed woodland mix planting; species to include Viburnum opulus, Acer campestre, Crataegus planted at 1m centre.
- Proposed amenity grass area, regularly mown.
- Existing naturalised scrub and tree planting to be retained to be managed by coppicing every 4no. years.
- Meadow Area - mown 3-4 times per annum to aid bio-diversity.
- Mono-planting of willow to define the upper most area of mounding within the play area.
- Naturalised bulb planting, tolerant of wet ground conditions including Camassia, Leucorum aestivum, fritillaria. Species to be altered at some locations to echo the geophysical layer and to support the archaeological interpretation.
- Core gravel stabilizer or similar on sloped locations.
- Main pathways finished with ballylusk gravel, 2.0m wide, no edging, mimicing existing desire lines.
- Cycleway - Black top finish with white thermoplastic markings(2.5m wide)
- Bitmac pathway (2.0m wide)
- Footpath allowing access for all
- Approximate area of tree and shrub removal.
- Existing railing to be upgraded as necessary.
- Existing geophysical base information
- Existing cross to be retained and protected in accordance with heritage consultants recommendations.
- Existing Lamp columns
- Proposed Lamp columns
- Proposed 900mm high berm along Glen Eilan Road
- Existing trees to be retained.
- Natural stone / suitable planting demarcating the disturbed graves.
- Freestanding medilith interpretive display panel.
